WORLD WAR 1

The primary list of teachers and old boys from the Terrace School who died on active service was compiled by the headmaster, Mr G MacMorran, in December 1919. The original records at the Alexander Turnbull Library are identified as MS-Papers-2682 and qMS-2011.

MacMorran was headmaster from 1884 – 1919 so he would have had a good knowledge of those who died in the war but as with any such list it may not be entirely accurate or complete.

As MacMorran himself stated in his retirement speech (reported by the Evening Post on 17 December 1919), the list of between 700 and 800 boys from the Terrace School who served in the war was far from complete and if he lived for twenty years he would still be adding names.

Nevertheless, MacMorran's list of the dead must be taken as definitive and recent research has only been undertaken to verify the names and connections with the Terrace School.

The following key sources were canvassed in the verification process:

- Military Service Records Archives NZ
- National Archives of Australia Service Records
- Ancestry UK Military Records
- Commonwealth War Graves Commission
- Online Cenotaph Auckland War Memorial Museum
- Newspaper Reports/Articles (Papers Past)
- Surviving Terrace School Class Lists (Agency code ADEX)– Archives NZ

With very few exceptions it has been possible to link all of the names to the Terrace School either through direct references, places of address or other connections. Only three names could not be verified and these are identified in the endnotes.

Valuable assistance was also provided by Colonel (Ret) Raymond Seymour, historian and Patron of the New Zealand Military Historical Society in checking all names and service numbers and adding references to rank, date and place of death and decorations.

*The names of S A Atkinson and the two Carson brothers did not appear on George MacMorran's original list but came to light in 2017 as the result of a search of the *New Zealand Times* which had previously been overlooked.

Additional comment from Raymond Seymour:

- No record of him in BDM database.
- A search of 12/2281 "Ellisdon Frederick Joseph Herring" being the only "Ellisdon" listed as KIA, failed to reveal any connection this deceased officer had with Wellington. Between 1896 1928, his father, being his NOK, resided in the Auckland region. However, in 1935 he did live in 58 Boulcott Street.
- Commonwealth War Graves Commission list just one "Ellisdon" in the Commonwealth to have been KIA during WW1 and that was Ellisdon Frederick Joseph Herring.
- Between 1/1/1876 and 31/12/1898 only five male Ellisdon's were born in NZ. None of them resembled Frederick Ellisdon.
- Between 1/1/1880 and 24/2/1938 there were no marriages in NZ of a Frederick Ellisdon.
- Between 1/1/1900 and 24/2/1968 only six male Ellisdon's died in NZ. None, apart from Frederick Joseph Herring Ellisdon, had any resemblance to the subject.

ⁱⁱ <u>Hall Arthur</u>: Two men named Arthur Hall were killed in action (6/1551 and 58524). No connection could be found to Wellington or the Terrace School with either. It is possible that another enlisted in Australia or the UK but in light of the number who died this would require a significant research effort. A total of 304 fit this description on the CWGC website.

Additional comment from Raymond Seymour:

- There were 10 "Arthur Hall's" who served in 1 NZEF during WW1. Of these 10, five were KIA. Only one of these five coincided with the subject. He was "23/2195 Hall, Arthur Thomas".
- He was a Sergeant at the time of his death and was serving with WIR.
- He was KIA on the 4th October 1917 in France.
- My money is on him as his father "Archibald Hall" was living at 93 Hill Street, Wellington during this period.

ⁱⁱⁱ Johnston Robert H: There is only one Robert H Johnston in the NZ service records and this individual, Robert Haldane Johnston (12/3063) appears to have no connection with Wellington or the Terrace School.

ⁱ <u>Ellisdon Fred A</u>: MacMorran's listing of Ellisdon as Fred A did not reveal any service record to match. The only Frederick Ellisdon to be killed was Frederick Joseph Herring Ellisdon 12/2281 but he was Auckland based. No connection with Wellington or the Terrace School could be found.

MacMorran lists a Robert C Johnston on his Samoa list but there is no service record in this name. Other spellings of the surname were also checked but with no result.

Additional comment from Raymond Seymour:

- Of the eight Johnston's who served with 1 NZEF during WW1, only one was KIA. He was 12/3063 Corporal Robert Haldane Johnston, of AIR, who DOW on the 5th October 1917.
- However, I could find no indication of any allegiance he may have had with Wellington.
- I researched every conceivable derivation of "Johnston" but to no avail.
- I researched <u>every</u> "Robert Johnston" in the Commonwealth War Graves Commission database also to no avail.
- Regrettably, I must 'surrender' on this one.

WORLD WAR 2

There is no known roll of pupils from the Terrace School who served in the second world war or any record of those who died on active service. However, the numbers would have been far less than those who participated in the Great War.

For Terrace School pupils to have been eligible to serve at some stage in WW2 they would have to have been at the school no later than say 1927. Given the losses in the Great War and the progressively declining rolls after 1918 the pool of eligible servicemen would therefore have reduced. The school eventually closed in 1934 and reopened as a side-school to the Kelburn School catering for younger pupils.

The following names have been located by searching newspaper reports on *Papers Past* between 1939-45 under the key words 'Terrace School'. The names were subsequently checked on the Auckland War Memorial Museum Online Cenotaph to verify the newspaper reports and to identify service numbers.
