years, be denied the enjoyment of what has been admitted by Parliament to be a just right, and will HEY therefore earnestly pray your Honourable House to adopt such measures as will enable Women to record their votes for Members of the House of Representatives at the ensuing General Election. HEY further pray that your Honourable House will pass no Electoral Bill which shall fail to secure to Women this privilege. And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray, &c.
