# We will remember them



These panels commemorate men associated with this district who died in the service of their country during World War 1. The captions were compiled using mainly information from military records. The Roll of Honour on the outside of the hall includes a number of errors that have been corrected here.

When the original Roll of Honour panels were unveiled at the opening of the Memorial Hall on 16 August 1922, the names of several other men from the district who also died in their country's service, but who were not listed on the panels, were read out. They are now included here.
